NORTHERN COLORADO FRONT RANGE FOOTHILLS AND URBAN CORRIDOR
THROUGH THIS EVENING. RAINFALL RATES UP TO 2 TO 3 INCHES
PER HOUR MAY LEAD TO FLASH FLOODING IN URBAN AREAS AND LOW LYING
AREAS SUSCEPTIBLE TO FLOODING. HEAVY RAINFALL COULD POSSIBLY
LINGER OVERNIGHT ON THE PLAINS.

.DAYS TWO THROUGH SEVEN...WEDNESDAY THROUGH MONDAY

THE WET PATTERN WITH SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS CAN BE EXPECTED
